Entries to the Award Recognition Program referred to in this document as "the Program," must be received by January 31, 2018 at 11:59 p.m. (Pacific Standard Time). Entries posted after this date will not be accepted. NAMM, The NAMM Foundation and The Lennon Bus are not responsible for typographical errors in related materials, late, lost, or misdirected links or online transactions that are lost, fail to be entered into the processing system or are processed or transmitted late. 2. Eligibility The Program is open to faculty advisors in K-12 school districts with music programs within the Continental United States. Employees and relatives of NAMM and The John Lennon Educational Tour Bus are not eligible to participate. Only one entry per K-12 School District will be accepted. Winners must be able to provide suitable parking for the John Lennon Educational Tour Bus within the Continental United States and agree to a date that must coincide with The John Lennon Educational Tour Bus schedule.

3. Award Selection: One K-12 School Districts will be selected on or about February 11, 2018. Odds of winning depend on the number of eligible entries received. One School District will be selected by The NAMM Foundation based on how well the video represents and answers, "What makes music education great in your school district?" No cash or credit alternative to the awards offered. Awards are not transferable. Awards are subject to availability. NAMM reserves the right to cancel or amend the Program, terms and conditions without notice at the discretion of the organizations, and/or in the event of a catastrophe, war, civil or military disturbance, act of God or any actual or anticipated breach of any applicable law or regulation or any other event outside of NAMM's control.

NAMM will notify any changes to the Program to entrants as soon as possible. Selected school district will be notified by **February 15, 2018.** The NAMM Foundation. If a winner cannot be contacted or does not claim the Award within three days of notification, we reserve the right to withdraw the Award from the winner and pick a replacement winner.

4. Video submissions: All videos submitted become the property of NAMM. Video submissions featuring copyrighted or non-original content, including musical soundtrack, will be rejected and disqualify from future participation. Not responsible for lost or misdirected entries. NAMM's decision in respect to all matters of the recognition Program are final. By entering the video recognition Program, you indicate you agree to and are bound by these terms and conditions. 5. In connection with the foregoing, you agree that you will: (i) confirm any waivers and consents from time to time as reasonably requested by the NAMM, and (ii) perform such other acts as NAMM may reasonably request to facilitate NAMM's right to use the video. With respect to any use by NAMM of the video, you hereby agree to waive any right that you may have to inspect or approve the video or the use to which it may be applied. NAMM shall have exclusive, full, and final control over its use of video, and nothing herein obligates NAMM to make any use of the video.

Entrants agree to the use of his/her name and image in any publicity material. Winner and other entrant contact information will be used solely in accordance with NAMM's privacy policy and will not be disclosed to a third party. You hereby agree to release NAMM and each of its related and affiliated entities, agents, employees, representatives, assignees, licensees, and successors from and against any and all claims, whether at law or in equity (including without limitation, injunctive relief), with respect to: (a) any liability based on any personal property, residual, reuse or other right which you may have by virtue of any permitted use of the video under this agreement, or as a result of the uses of the video or any portion thereof or in connection with advertising and promotion for the video and/or other productions in which the video is utilized by NAMM and its affiliates; (b) any claim arising out of any permitted acts or statements made in connection with the video and/or other productions in which the video is utilized (including but not limited to defamation, invasion of privacy by publication of private facts, false light, misappropriation, infringement of your right of publicity, intrusion, infliction of emotional distress and any other violations of personal and/or property rights including both intentional or unintentional acts or omissions); (c) any claim or damage on account of personal injury to you that may arise from your participation in connection with the video including bodily injury, lost wages, loss of employment and emotional distress; and (d) any claim for further consideration or compensation for your participation in or with the video or the rights granted hereunder.
