



The Women of NAMM (WoN) Summit **Application Guidelines**

Women of NAMM (WoN) (Formerly Smart Women In Music): Women of NAMM (WoN) is a council of the National Association of Music Merchants (NAMM) dedicated to increasing female representation in the industry. WoN will continue to pursue the vision, mission, and objectives set forth by SWIM for the benefit of women in the music products industry and expand to include female professionals in other NAMM member categories including the pro audio and entertainment technology segments.

Women of NAMM (WoN) Summit Program Statement of Purpose: The WoN Summit program supports women working in the music products industry and their goals to connect, support and grow their leadership and professional abilities. An annual leadership immersion experience will be offered with the applicants receiving the educational experience covered by the awarded scholarship.

The WoN Fund envisions a future state of the music industry where at least 10% of the CEO roles are held by women (current state is 2.2%) and 50% of C-suite positions are held by women. Our focus with this program is to build leadership skills, confidence and a lifelong network for inspired, driven women to reach this goal within the next 10 years.

Key Goals and Educational Overview: The **WoN Summit program** will connect and build relationships with other high-performance women in the music industry. Workshops and sessions will focus on.

- Identifying personal leadership strengths and enhancing them
- Improving communication and influence skills
- Learning effective models for giving and receiving feedback
- Building skills in resilience and mindset
- Creating concrete and actionable goals to enhance personal and professional effectiveness

This program focuses on world class professional development, leadership training and building strong lifelong relationships between the attendees.

Award: Up to 16 WoN Summit scholarships are awarded. The two-day leadership summit includes an opening and closing reception, meals during the summit and travel to/from the hotel to NAMM headquarters. This is an estimated grant value of \$7,000.

Summit scholarship awardees cover their costs for travel to San Diego, California, hotel, and travel to/from the airport and any other incidentals.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Women who have at least five years of experience working in the music products industry and seek opportunities to expand their leadership and professional competencies.
- Participants must be at manager level or higher.
- Applicants should model the mission of WoN to connect, support and grow opportunities for themselves and all women in the music products industry.
- Must work for a NAMM member company.

Scholarship Requirements:

- Attendance at all the summit’s educational and networking activities; including the two-days of training, the opening reception, and the closing reception.
- Submit a final report that summarizes learnings and take-aways from the program to help the WoN Governance continue to build future programming.
